



Corilus is the new name for OmegaSoft

Major supplier of IT solutions for the medical sector in Belgium changes its name and presents new strategy

NAZARETH/KRUIBEKE (BELGIUM), 21 MARCH 2007 – OmegaSoft has changed its name into Corilus. Together with Fagron Group, Arseus Dental and Arseus Medical, Corilus forms **Arseus**, the 'business-to-business' division of Omega Pharma. Anticipating the autonomy and the IPO of Arseus in 2008, the organization has adopted a new name that does no longer refer to Omega Pharma.

Corilus is the biggest supplier of IT solutions for the medical sector in Belgium. In The Netherlands, Corilus has a strong position on the IT market for veterinarians and in France for the 'centres de soins'.



Corilus has based its new name on the botanic term for the hazel tree (corylus) to which medicinal effects are attributed. The branches of the hazel tree, too, can be seen as a reference to the various medical 'branches' for which Corilus provides total IT solutions, e.g.: pharmacists, dentists, GPs, specialist physicians, ophthalmologists, opticians, home care staff and managers of hospitals and homes for the elderly, etc. Along with the new name comes a new logo, which evokes both the branches of the hazel tree as brains - referring to the intellectual labor of the Corilus staff.

“We continue to focus on our mission: to supply powerful solutions for medical practitioners, enabling them to perform even better,” states Ronny Robbrecht, general manager Corilus. “With a total solution designed by Corilus, healthcare specialist can fully concentrate on their practice, without the need to worry about the technical infrastructure”.

In the framework of the renewed strategy, Corilus has developed new 'Comfort Service' contracts. In function of this needs and budgetary requirements, the customer can choose between the Gold, Silver or Bronze service pack, offering respectively premium, standard and basic service levels.

As an illustration of the innovative power of Corilus, a first demo was given of the new Vista-ready software for pharmacists, Greenock. The first field tests with Greenock will be initiated later this year, and the commercialization is scheduled to take a start early 2008.

With 200 employees, based in 6 sites in 3 countries (Belgium, The Netherlands and France), Corilus has posted an annual turnover of over 25 million euro. In Belgium alone, the customer base includes over 10,000 medical professionals and continues to grow.
